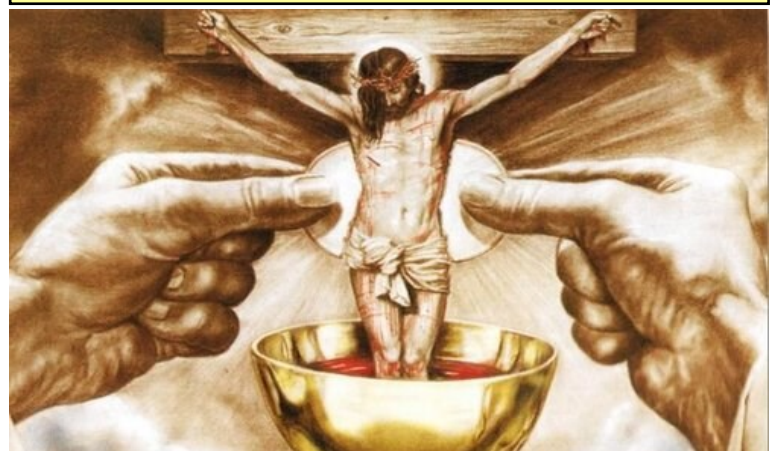

When Moses came to the people and related all the words and ordinances of the LORD, they all answered with one voice, "We will do everything that the LORD has told us." ### \* 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: Hebrews 9: 11-15

Brothers and sisters: When Christ came as high priest of the good things that have come to be, passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation, he entered once for all into the sanctuary, not with the blood of goats and calves but with his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our

consciences from dead works to worship the living God. For this reason he is mediator of a new covenant: since a death has taken place for deliverance from transgressions under the first covenant, those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance.

### \* Gospel Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26

On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?" He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. - » Be skeptical of unsolicited emails and messages
- » Be cautious when you get texts or emails from unknown sources, especially if

they are asking for personal information, financial details, or to click on suspicious links. Review the email domain to see if there are any misspellings, odd words or letters, or any other unusual parts.

- »
  - » Verify websites and check URLs
- » Before entering any personal information or financials on a website, make sure it is secure and legitimate. Check for HTTPS in the URL and look for security certificates. Avoid sites with misspelled URLs or domains that imitate popular brands.
- »
  - » Use strong and unique passwords
- » When creating online accounts, avoid using the same password for multiple websites. Consider using a password manager to generate and store complex passwords securely. This is especially important for accounts holding important and private information.
- »
  - » Two-Factor Authentication:
    - » Whenever it is possible, enable two-factor authentication on your accounts. This adds an extra layer of security to your account by requiring a second form of verification, like a code sent to your cell phone, or email. This can help prevent unauthorized access even if your password information is compromised.
- »
  - » Stay Informed and Educated:
    - Stay updated on common online scams and various techniques used by scammers. Educate yourself, family members, and coworkers about how to recognize scams.
