Hi everyone! I am very grateful to be installed as your 6<sup>th</sup> pastor this Sunday, August 17<sup>th</sup> at 10:30am Mass! I want to thank you for your warm reception of me this past year and all of the support and affirmation you have given me this past year. Our Lady of Guadalupe is a beautiful community with many people of great humility and kindness. I look forward to the opportunity to continue to Shepherd you with Fr. Jeffrey, Fr. Pat, Deacon Dave, and the staff. It is also a blessing this weekend to have Bishop Malesic come for the first time to our parish!

My role as your pastor is to be your spiritual father, to lead this community to be nourished and fed by the Lord through the Word and the Sacraments, and to send us out on mission into our community to be His visible presence to others where we can invite the lost into a relationship with Jesus Christ and serve the needs of others in the way God calls us to. It's important to remember that parishes exist to bring people into an encounter with Christ and to send them out. We do this not just individually but as a community – we worship Him together at Holy Mass and we go out to gather the lost in our community.

As your spiritual father and pastor, the first most important thing I can do is help you to listen and respond to God's call in your life. Biological fathers provide for their families through their work, their relationship with their families, and help to meet their daily needs in this world. Spiritual fathers help their spiritual children to trust in their Heavenly Father's plan for their lives and live in obedience to His will. If I am doing my work well as your pastor these spiritual fruits will continue to grow and we will bring more people to the Lord through OCIA, the sacraments, and continue to nourish people with our faith.

I look forward to working with the parish staff, parish council, finance council and other ministry leaders to continue to build God's Kingdom in the Macedonia community through our parish. I humbly ask for your prayers that I lead this community the way God intends and allow myself to be His instrument for you all and lead us forward.

We have been reading through the Book of Deuteronomy in the daily Mass cycle and this past Tuesday in chapter 31:1-8 and we heard about Moses approaching his death and transitioning leadership with Joshua who would lead the people Israel into the Promised Land through the river Jordan. I love these words from Moses to Joshua as he passes on the leadership role, "Be brave and steadfast, for you must bring this people into the land which the Lord swore to their fathers he would give them; you must put them in possession of their heritage. It is the Lord who marches before you; he will be with you and will never fail you or forsake you. So, do not fear or be dismayed."

## The Liturgy of The Word

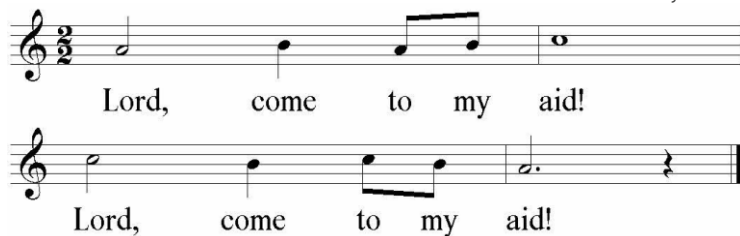
### \*1<sup>st</sup> Reading *Jeremiah 38: 4-6, 8-10*

In those days, the princes said to the king: "Jeremiah ought to be put to death; he is demoralizing the soldiers who are left in this city, and all the people, by speaking such things to them; he is not interested in the welfare of our people, but in their ruin." King Zedekiah answered: "He is in your power"; for the king could do nothing with them. And so they took Jeremiah and threw him into the cistern of Prince Malchiah, which was in the quarters of the guard, letting him down with ropes. There was no water in the cistern, only mud, and Jeremiah sank into the mud. Ebed-melech, a court official, went there from the palace and said to him: "My lord king, these men have been at fault in all they have done to the prophet Jeremiah, casting him into the cistern. He will die of famine on the spot, for there is no more food in the city." Then the king ordered Ebed-melech the Cushite to take three men along with him, and draw the prophet Jeremiah out of the cistern before he should die.




