Thank you for your prayers and support and I continue to ask for that as we journey forward. Thank you to the staff for all of the preparation and hard work to prepare both the Mass and the gathering after Mass. I thought it all came out beautifully and the most important aspect to me was to have this opportunity to gather us all together – both for Liturgy with our Bishop and to spend time together after. I pray we can continue to grow as one as a community of faith, and that we can live each day for Christ in the world so that the people of Macedonia can discover or rediscover God's love for them and respond to His call.

I am very excited for our parish picnic this weekend too! Please come join us for Mass and our annual picnic after the 10:30am Mass this Sunday, August 24th.

At the end of the Installation Mass Bishop Malesic gave us a wonderful reflection on a few things that he thought we should hear. One comment he made was that it was so good to have children at Mass and hear the crying of the babies. And he went on to remind us that without that we have no future as a Church. I agree that it is such a gift and a joy to see families and children come to Mass. There are so many competing voices in their lives for what to do on a Sunday morning. We probably never thought we would see this day but as of recently there are sports games, and outside commitments on Sunday mornings. The secular world could care less about your Sunday morning and going to Church and there is absolutely no respect for Sunday worship anymore from the outside world. This means that it takes even more sacrifice and commitment for parents to bring their children each week to Mass. This puts parents in a difficult place. But then, how even more powerful it is when they do make that sacrifice and commitment to God to put Him and worship of Him before their sports games or other worldly commitments! It makes this "yes" to God even more meaningful since it is so much connected with sacrifice and intentionality.

Again, thank you for that "yes" last weekend and I pray we can continue to give that "yes" each Sunday to God (or vigil Mass). We cannot bend to the world's ways but must be prophets in our world today and speak for God. This isn't true just for Sunday Mass but also for living His commandments each day and taking time to grow in our relationship with God each day. This truly takes commitment and sacrifice because the world will always ask more of us but we just simply must make time for God.

I would really like to ask all of our parishioners to be patient with the younger children and parents and be welcoming of them even if you have not seen them in a while or get frustrated because the kids are struggling to stay focused during Mass. Please "embrace" the children and the messiness of life.
