Hi everyone! Last weekend I did the blessing for our newly formed Parish Council for our parish. I am very grateful to these Council members for saying "yes" to serve on Parish Council. Parish Council represents the people of the parish so please feel free to reach out to any of them if you have concerns, comments, or feedback. The Council member pictures and names are on the bulletin board as you walk into church. You are also welcome to directly email or call me, Fr. Jeffrey, Fr. Pat, or Deacon Dave if you need to!

I am excited to begin a Tuesday Holy Hour the **first Tuesday of each month at 6:30pm**. The first one will be this Tuesday, October 7th at 6:30pm. We will have confession from 6:30-7:15pm and close with Benediction at 7:30pm. You are welcome to come and pray for as long as you want (no need to stay the whole hour unless you want) and of course are welcome to confession as you see fit.

St. Michael, St. Gabriel, and St. Raphael all share that Feast day from this past Monday and are given to us by God as the three Archangels. We believe God has created both human beings and angelic creatures. Angels, as we know do not have bodies like human beings and are pure spirits. They are God's messengers and are frequently seen in the Bible as being sent by God for some particular mission. St. Michael is the protector of Israel as we see in the book of Daniel. St. Michael is also the one God sends to wage war on Satan and the fallen angels to cast them into hell as seen in the book of Revelation. Thus St. Michael is known as a great defender and protector for us and the Church. He is the one to call upon especially in times of spiritual warfare. There are times in all of our lives, especially if we are trying to grow closer to God, that the Devil or one of his fallen angels will attack us in certain ways. Sometimes this is through temptations, different forms of darkness, or in other ways. We conquer the fallen angels and their lies by turning to Christ and His army of defenders like St. Michael. Spiritual battles are won through prayer and the sacraments. A wise, old exorcist priest once taught me that making a good confession is one of the greatest ways to defeat the Enemy. This is because we are letting Jesus take away our sins through confession which is the greatest place for the Devil to work in our lives. But also calling upon the angels and especially St. Michael is an important part of being victorious in spiritual warfare. We conclude every daily Mass with the St. Michael prayer for this reason.

As we know from the New Testament, St. Gabriel has the amazing role of announcing the Good News to Zechariah about the coming birth of John the Baptist. Even better, Gabriel is called and sent by God to announce the Good News to Mary that the Eternal Son of the Father will become Incarnate in her womb! God chooses to work in amazing ways through the angels to serve us, protect us, and announce Good News to us!

Lastly, St. Raphael is known as a messenger of healing. In the book of Tobit St. Raphael is sent by God to bring remedy and healing to Tobit's family. If we need healing for ourselves or someone else we are invited to call upon the help and intercession of St. Raphael.







RESPECT LIFE MONTH OCTOBER 2025

Every October, we celebrate Respect Life Month. We consider more deeply why every human life is valuable and reflect on how to build a culture that protects life from conception to natural death. 
