From the Pastor

Hi everyone! I would like to start this column off by welcoming Maggie Wancheck to our parish staff. Maggie has been a parishioner of Our Lady of Guadalupe for more than 20 years and is working the front desk Tuesday through Thursday each week! Please Welcome Maggie next time you stop through the office.

I hope and pray you had a very blessed Easter celebration!! I am so grateful to God for the beautiful Holy Week and the participation of so many this past week in coming to the Liturgies, Confessions, Stations, and all that was offered! It was truly a week of many graces and the working of the Holy Spirit was so evident! I would like to thank all the staff and volunteers for an incredible amount of effort put into decorations, setting up and cleaning up from our sacristans, altar servers, musicians, OCIA team, liturgical ministers, greeters, ushers and just all of you that gave so much!! It is the Lord working through all of our efforts and in ways that we do not know that makes Holy Week and Easter so powerful!

I would also like to thank again all the volunteers that worked the Fish Fry. This was a huge success for us, so thank you for being so giving of your time to this community gathering and fundraiser!

Each of our Liturgies was up in attendance this past Holy Week and Easter, which really is a gift to see people making their way back! Also, Fr. Jeffrey brought in 4 people into the Catholic Church through the Easter Vigil, which is amazing!! This Easter season, as we celebrate the greatest event in world history, Jesus rising from the dead, we are reminded that we have a real calling this season. Easter is not just time to celebrate (even though that is part of it) but it is also time to spread the faith. Our readings pull us right into this reality as we hear from The Acts of the Apostles this Easter season where Peter is going out and preaching about Jesus being raised and that we have forgiveness of sins in Him. Also, in the Gospels when Jesus encounters His Apostles and Disciples, He reveals to them His power over sin and death by being raised and also immediately commissions them to go out and forgive sins as He says, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." (John 20:22-23) Also, in the Gospels, Jesus encounters Mary Magdalene in His Risen Body and tells her to go tell His Disciples what she has seen.

The point is that Jesus rises and meets His followers and immediately commissions them to both share the Good News that He is risen and to forgive sins (to The Apostles). They are all in some way sent out to share the Good News of His Resurrection and that we can be forgiven in His name and have new life in Him (and eternal life). This message is meant to be spread, not just contained, within His circle of followers. This is the same for us too as members of His Body, the Church! I encourage you to take the time to read through Acts of The Apostles and these accounts of The Resurrection of Jesus at the end of the Gospels. Let this reality sink into your own life and pray these 50 days of the Easter season to better understand how God is calling you to share the Good News of Jesus Risen!

I have heard from some many people about how powerful Holy Week and Easter was here for them at St. Barnabas. I am incredibly grateful that you shared this Good News of God's grace with me as your pastor, but have you shared it with anyone who has fallen away from the faith or someone who needs to hear how God is at work in your life? There are people in your life that need this testimony and need the invitation to revisit or visit for the first time an active relationship with Jesus. Who in your life needs to hear this from you and needs a gentle nudge or invitation from you? This is the Easter calling, not to just rejoice that He is risen and at work in our lives, but to let the graces of the Resurrection overflow into many more lives and we need to be His agents of spreading this message about Jesus!

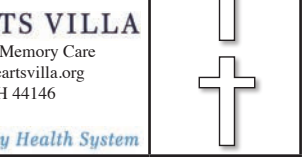
