From the Pastor

Hi everyone! It was a blessing to give First Holy Communion to our second graders last Sunday at 10:30 am Mass! I am very grateful to the families of the second graders for raising their children in the Catholic faith and leading them to the Sacraments. Please continue to water and nourish these graces your children are receiving by living in an authentic Christian household that worships God on Sundays at Holy Mass, prays each day and serves Him intentionally in your daily life. Thank you also to Matt Griffith and the whole volunteer team that prepares the children for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion!

Next Sunday, May 17th, we will have Confirmation at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish for both St. Barnabas and Our Lady of Guadalupe Confirmandi. Please pray the teens open wide their hearts to the gifts of the Holy Spirit as they receive the graces of Confirmation next weekend!

This weekend in the secular culture, we celebrate Mother's Day. Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers, grandmothers, and spiritual mothers! We are so grateful for all the sacrifices you make in giving your lives to your families. Please know you are greatly appreciated! This is one of the few weekends a year you can "guilt" your families into coming to Mass with you so don't miss the opportunity to bring your family to Mass this weekend to kick off Mother's Day the right way!

We have all received the Holy Spirit through Baptism and Confirmation but sometimes we need the extra prayer support to stir up the Spirit once again within us to help us live Spirit-led lives and understand more clearly the work of the Spirit each day. It can be easy with the challenges of life to get caught in despair, become discouraged and afraid, or fall back into old habits. Sometimes we need prayers for courage, healing, and strength to continue our mission boldly as the early Apostles did.


As we are approaching Pentecost, our readings are inviting us to prepare to receive the Holy Spirit. As I mentioned above, we have received the Holy Spirit through the Sacraments; however as part of our spiritual journey, we are always looking to grow deeper in the life of the Spirit that is in us. Many of us do not follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit in our daily life or even know what the promptings of the Spirit are like. Do you have a sense of the movements of the Spirit in your daily life? Do you invite the Holy Spirit into your decision making, daily actions, relationships, and work?

These few weeks leading up to Pentecost are important for us to increase our desire for the Holy Spirit, and ask the Father to send the Spirit anew in our lives. This is an opportunity to recognize our need for the Spirit and long for Him to act powerfully each day in us.

Start by asking the Holy Spirit to pour into your life again. Perhaps you have been carrying a heavy cross in your life. Ask the Spirit to rush into that place and drive out all fear and fill you with His peace. Learn to depend on the supernatural grace, strength and peace of the Holy Spirit in your daily life. Jesus says in this weekend's Gospel, "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows him. But you know him, because he remains with you, and will be in you (NAB, John 14:16-17)."

Again, these few weeks we are invited to desire more of the Spirit's work in our daily life. Pick up this weekend's readings to help you pray with this desire and recognize this need in your life to know and understand the promptings of the Holy Spirit who is your advocate, helper, and consoler given to us by the Father! We must stop leaning on our own strength and will, and depend on the gift of the Spirit!

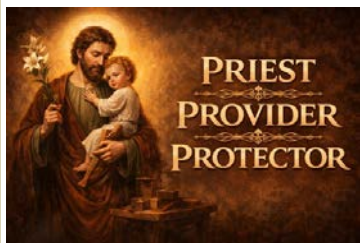
