From the Pastor

Hi, everyone!

This Sunday, we have Confirmation Mass at Our Lady of Guadalupe at 1pm for both St. Barnabas and Our Lady of Guadalupe parishes. Please pray for our teens as they receive Confirmation and pray for them to respond generously to the graces they are about to receive.

Saturday, May 17th is the Ordination of six young men to the Priesthood for the Diocese of Cleveland! We are very blessed in our Diocese to have several men getting ordained every year. Please pray for them. them. and their transition into Priesthood!

This Sunday, we celebrate The Solemnity of the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven. The Ascension takes place 40 days after Jesus rose from the dead as the Scriptures tell us. Technically, this year, 40 days takes us to last Thursday, May 14th, but the Diocese of Cleveland chooses to move the Solemnity to this Sunday the 17th to be celebrated as a Sunday Liturgy.

This Solemnity celebrates Jesus being taken up bodily into Heaven. The rupture between Heaven and earth that took place at the fall (see Genesis) is now being reunited in the person of Jesus Christ as He takes on our earthly body and brings "earth" back into Heaven through His Ascension. So, it is in Jesus that Heaven and earth are reunited and it is in our union with Jesus that Heaven and earth come together in our lives. This will be fully realized for us in next week's celebration of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit descends upon The Apostles and they are given this Divine Spirit to now live in them and bless them with supernatural gifts.

We experience these supernatural graces of the Spirit through the gift of the Sacraments as we receive Him in Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist. Through these Sacraments, Heaven enters us and we are united with Christ, which is what makes the reception of these Sacraments so crucial to our growth in holiness! Holiness is always first about what God chooses to do to us and then our response to His graces!

If we just listen to the words given to us from Matthew's Gospel for this weekend, it gives us good insight on how to approach this Solemnity. In Matthew 28, Jesus tells His Eleven Disciples, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (NAB, Matthew 28:18-20)


Even though Jesus is ascending to the Father, His focus remains on the mission on earth, but now through The Apostles. In a sense, they will pick up where He left off but, of course, it will be the work of the Spirit through them that will continue the mission. We should take seriously the basic instruction Jesus gives them, which is to make disciples, baptize, and teach them. This is at the heart of our mission too, which is to help people to be disciples and true followers of Jesus. This does not just mean we give them Sacraments and then they "graduate" from Church, but rather they become intentional followers of Jesus. As a Church, this is something we must continue to work on. Too many people receive His graces through the Sacraments and never return and this is a huge problem!

Secondly, Jesus says to baptize the nations. We know Baptism to be the first Sacrament and so Baptism initiates them into the work of the Spirit and is the beginning of the Sacramental life. Jesus wants His followers to receive the supernatural graces of the Sacraments as we discussed above and this is crucial to our Christian journey.

Lastly, Jesus says to teach them and so catechesis remains another really important part of the Christian journey. We must teach the faith and help others to observe His commandments as Christ says. As you go out to do the work of the Lord in your life, remember that we want to make disciples and true followers of Jesus, bring them to the Sacraments, and instruct people in the faith! Which of these do you find most difficult?

* **1st Reading**

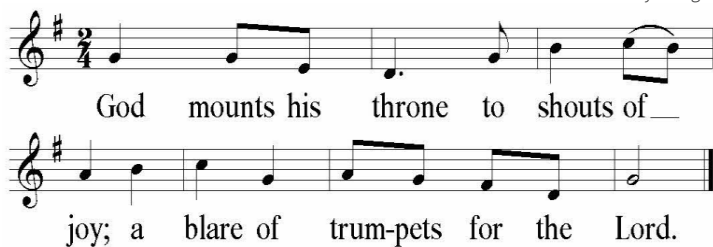
Acts 1: 1-11

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father

about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered together they asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

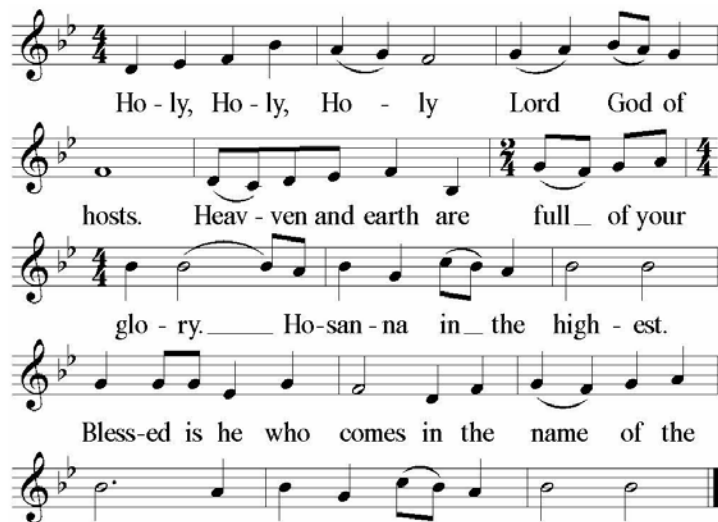

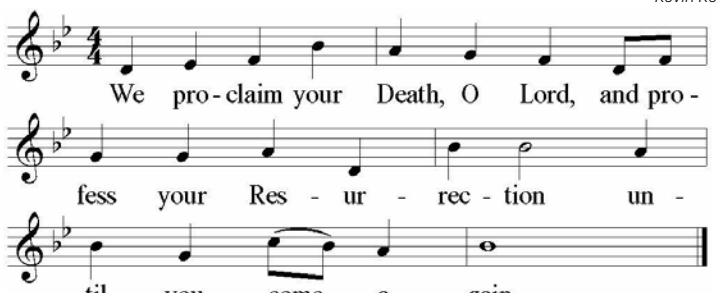

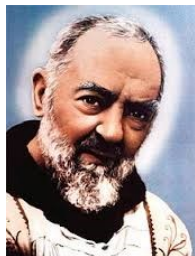
