From the Pastor

Hi, everyone!

Next week is the Feast of Corpus Christi and we will have the procession with the Blessed Sacrament right after the 10:30am Mass just like last year. This will be a short outdoor procession and will close with Benediction (blessing of the Eucharist) by the Mary Shrine. We will also have an ice cream truck after to enjoy a little time together with a cold treat! Please come join us next week for the 10:30am procession!

This weekend, we celebrate Trinity Sunday. Throughout salvation history and especially through Jesus, God has revealed Himself to be One God in Three Divine Persons. This is the central mystery of our faith since it reveals who God is in Himself.

You and I are destined to be in eternal Communion with the Holy Trinity. This is what it means to be in Heaven and this is literally what we are made for - to share in God's eternal life.

At first thought, this might seem a bit abstract but everything good on earth is like a little sign that points to the eternal mystery of the Trinity. Even the most simple, ordinary moments of life in some way point to and reveal the mystery of the Trinity and what we are destined for.

For example, some of the most enjoyable times in life are not when we are "doing" anything but just "being" with someone or just simply delighting in life. I think about my favorite time with a good friend is enjoying walking and sharing in conversation or having a good meal together. We look forward to the time we spend with family and friends. It is truly restful to be in the presence of people we love and this gives us something to look forward to after a stressful week of work or tough day. We delight and rest in the presence of others especially with people we love.

This restfulness with others is a little image that points to our desire to rest and be in the presence of God. We have no one in life who loves us more than God and there is no one else who understands us more. Being in the presence of God is our ultimate rest, peace and happiness and we get glimpses of this when we are with people we love. We get even stronger glimpses of this when we learn how to pray and be in His presence and allow Him to delight in us. This is really at the heart and center of prayer - to delight in God and allow Him to delight in us. This is again what we are truly made for and are destined for all eternity. In Heaven, the veil will be lifted and we will be able to easily rejoice in being with God!

This is also the point of doing Sundays well. God commands us to rest on Sunday - the day we celebrate Jesus' Resurrection. This does not mean we just sleep all day but rather that we delight in God, in our family and in life and we spend time with those we love. We begin the Sunday rest by entering into communion with God at Holy Mass to offer Him worship, thanks and praise. The Sunday rest done well is a sign that points to our eternal rest in Heaven with the Blessed Trinity.

Think of a Sunday where you went to Mass and felt His peace again in your heart. Then you perhaps enjoyed the day with your family and shared in your favorite meal with good conversation, laughter and delighted in life and one another. This again is a sign of Heaven! We have so much to look forward to in being with God! Obsessing over earthly pleasures last only a moment and then we never can have enough of them but when we allow ourselves to be drawn to the Holy Trinity we experience lasting peace and deeper purpose of what life is really about.

This Trinity Sunday, please take the time to delight in God and allow Him to delight in you. Receive Him in Word and Sacrament through Holy Mass and enjoy time with your family. We must begin to enjoy Heaven now so we all the more look forward to Heaven for eternity!

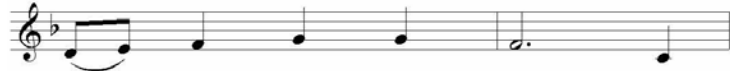

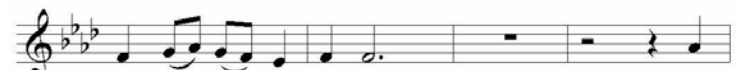

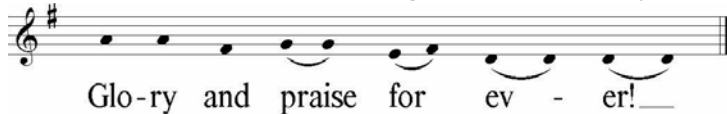
