From the Pastor

Hi, everyone! It's unbelievable that we are already in the month of May and celebrating the Fifth Sunday of Easter! This weekend, there are five men getting ordained to the permanent diaconate at the Cathedral. One of these men is Bill Prebel, who has been with us on assignment for the past year. Bill was assigned to us from the seminary back in the fall and has been a part of various ministries throughout the year like lecturing, serving Mass, Eucharistic ministry, and has come to staff and parish council meetings, along with other ministries. Bill has been in formation for the past five years and will be serving at his home parish, Saints Cosmas and Damian, as a deacon. Please pray for Bill and his classmates this weekend as they receive Deaconate Ordination!

I celebrated several First Holy Communions last weekend and have First Communions this weekend at our parish. Please pray for these children and their families! This is an exciting time to be leading our children to Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist!

It is always a gift to see the children get excited to come to the Eucharist for the first time and when I talk with them before Mass, many of them are even nervous for this moment. I love also watching the excitement of the families bringing their kids to Jesus in the Eucharist and celebrating this beautiful day! It is a gift to be their Shepherd and share in this joyful day! And it is a gift to feed them with the Body and Blood of Jesus and as the Lord says, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day." (NAB, John 6:54)

My prayer for these children to receive First Holy Communion and for each of us is that we don't forget the excitement of this first time coming to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. It is easy to fall into a sort of laziness and apathy with something so good! We do this all the time in ordinary day-to-day living. Perhaps your marriage felt this way and in the beginning was the most exciting time of your life and that excitement fell away over time. Maybe you felt this way when you first started your career or even volunteering somewhere like a parish ministry. You felt the initial excitement and then over time it died off in some way. Of course, this is a normal part of life and a very normal feeling. There is nothing to be ashamed of when we lose excitement of something over time. We have to learn to commit and persevere with many things in life.

When we are talking about something so important like the Eucharist, we need to look deeper than our feelings. Our feelings come and go and often can be like a roller coaster ride. Some days, the excitement is there and other days it just feels flat. In our spiritual journey, we need to acknowledge our feelings, but make commitment with our will. Even when we talk about loving someone, we are really talking about willing that person's good, not just assessing how we feel about them in a particular moment. In fact, someone might have hurt us and we don't feel good about them, but we still choose to love them by willing their good. For example, we might pray for their conversion and choose to forgive them, even if our feelings are still not in the best place.

First Holy Communion is a very exciting time and filled with good feelings and emotions as the children dress up nicely to enter into this special day and families are filled with excitement for this joyful day in their child's life. However, it is so crucial that we continue to pursue Jesus in the Eucharist after First Communion! We might have lost that initial excitement, but our need for the Eucharist each week always remains. We have to dig deep and use our will to choose to go to Jesus in the Eucharist each Sunday and make that commitment, even if some of the excitement is gone. God often does His greatest work in our lives when we are in those moments and choosing Him regardless of how we feel. This is what it means to love. This is how we are to love our families too. Even if your children upset you, you still choose them and pursue them. You still choose to will their good, even when they disappoint you.

It would be good for each of us to remember a time when we did have a consoling moment before the Eucharist. This will help us remember that the Eucharist is truly a gift. Please also choose to come to God even when you don't feel like it and make a true commitment to Him, especially in the Holy Eucharist. This shows God, and you, that you truly do love Him! And I would bet you will receive graces you never expected when you consistently choose Him in the Eucharist!

The Liturgy of The Word

* **1st Reading:**

Acts 6: 1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." The

proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them. The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.






