From the Pastor

Hi, everyone!

I hope you have been enjoying this beautiful weather and the beginning of summer break! I hope you have a great summer but also continue practicing your faith. We all desire rest and recovery and to enjoy these summer days and there are so many opportunities to do this over these summer months. Please never forget the Lord is the one who can truly lead us to restful waters (see Psalm 23) and help us to find true inner peace and rest. Please keep Him priority this summer and come to Mass each week and spend time in prayer and Christian service. I absolutely love doing morning runs over the summer while the sun

is coming up – it is a wonderful opportunity to praise God while enjoying His creation! Take the time to contemplate the Lord’s beauty in the outdoors, and come to the Sacraments each week! He will lead you to find true rest, peace and recovery this summer.

We have two very exciting events coming up at Our Lady of Guadalupe! This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi which is the celebrating the true presence of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. We remember that through the consecration at Mass the bread and wine change substance into Jesus’ flesh and blood as He discusses in the Gospel of John Chapter 6. Jesus says, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him (NAB, John 6:53-56)." We should not take these words of Jesus lightly – He places a great deal of emphasis on His real presence in the Eucharist and the real necessity for you and I to consume His Body and Blood. This sacramental presence of Jesus is so much at the center of our worship and Communion with God that it deserves a feast day to remind us of the incredible gift of the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, the Church also invites us to process with Jesus in the Eucharist outside of the church walls. We come to the Holy Eucharist to offer our lives in union with Jesus’ perfect offering at Mass, then to be in Communion with Him as we consume the Eucharist, and then to go out and proclaim Him during our week. The procession is a way that the whole Church community can come together to bear witness to Jesus publicly. After all, we are called to bring Him to our city and people we meet each day and this procession is a sign of this great calling that we have each day. This year, Fr. Pat will lead the procession with Jesus in the monstrance (what holds the Eucharist) and process through the parking lot to Shepard Road and back and close with benediction (blessing with the Eucharist) to finish. Please come join us this Sunday at 10:30am for Mass and the procession!

As you come to Mass this weekend and we celebrate Corpus Christi, please make the effort to really open your heart during the consecration as you are kneeling in the pew. As the priest is consecrating the host, place yourself upon the altar. Give Jesus your heart and life, and ask Him for whatever grace you need. When you come to receive Him in the Eucharist, be extra aware of His real presence and when you say “Amen” to the “Body of Christ” really say it with belief in your heart that his is Him. Let’s try to focus ourselves the best we can this weekend and really appreciate His gift to us in the Holy Eucharist. May we allow all the graces the Lord is offering to truly transform us as we worship and receive Him this weekend!
