From Fr. Jeffrey Lindholm

I can scarcely believe that I have been here at OLG for over a year now! I want to begin by thanking all of you for your hospitality in welcoming me as your priest over the past year. It has been a gift learning how to shepherd and be a priest here at OLG. You have all taught me how to shepherd, and I look forward to continuing to minister as your priest over the next three years!

As we continue to journey throughout the summer, there is a stark invitation from our Lord to stay focused on Him. In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus says, "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me" (Mt. 10:37-38 NABRE). By no means is this an easy teaching from Jesus! Jesus is *not* saying that we should hate our mothers and fathers! Rather, Jesus is asking us to take an honest look within our hearts and to see *what the most important thing in our lives is*. Is God number one? Or do worries and preoccupations with family, friendships, work, etc. take precedence over our relationship with God?

As Father James has said over the past couple of weeks, it is necessary to take a look within our own "house," if you will. God is the constructor and the master crafter; we are the clay that He molds into a masterpiece. That, of course, requires a certain humility on our end to let God be the potter, and we be the clay. All too often, we reverse the roles – we plan, craft, and mold our lives according to what *I* want, without necessarily taking a moment to pray whether this is what God wants us to do.

When God takes precedence over *everything* in our lives, everything else falls into place: family, friendships, work, school, sports, etc. That is not to say that our lives will be free from suffering. In fact, Jesus continues in this weekend's Gospel, "and whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it" (Mt. 10:39, NABRE). While this teaching might seem daunting, Jesus is really inviting us to unite our suffering and sacrifice to His perfect sacrifice on the cross. There is actually something really beautiful here: by our Lord's perfect sacrifice, our sacrifices and sufferings are never in vain. We are never alone when we embrace the cross. Jesus has embraced all of what it means to be human (minus sin), embracing even our weak and broken state. Why should we not turn to Him in *everything* then?

In this, I am reminded of a prayer attributed to St. Oscar Romero (but really written by Ken Untener):

It helps, now and then, to step back and take the long view.

The Kingdom is not only beyond our efforts; it is even beyond our vision.

We accomplish in our lifetime only a fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is God's work.

Nothing we do is complete, which is another way of saying that the Kingdom always lies beyond us.

No statement says all that could be said. No prayer fully expresses our faith. No confession brings perfection. No pastoral visit brings wholeness. No program accomplishes the church's mission. No set of goals and objectives includes everything.

This is what we are about.

We plant the seeds that one day will grow. We water the seeds already planted, knowing that they hold future promise. We lay foundations that will need further development. We provide yeast that produces effects far beyond our capabilities.

We cannot do everything and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something and to do it well. It may be incomplete, but it is a beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest. We may never see the end results, but that is the difference between the master builder and the worker.

We are workers, not master builders; ministers, not messiahs.

Indeed we are workers in the vineyard of the Lord. May we place the Lord first in our lives so that we may be ministers, not messiahs.
