From the Pastor, Fr. James Kulway

Hi everyone! I hope you had a wonderful 4th of July celebration and had the opportunity to celebrate with family and friends. We are certainly grateful to God for 250 years as a nation! We remember and give thanks for all of those who have given their lives for our freedom as a nation and for those who continue to put themselves “on the line” for us!

The United States Catholic Bishops officially consecrated the U.S. to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 11, 2026 in celebrating the anniversary of 250 years as a nation. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has been a part of the life of the Church for many years and in particular was highlighted through St. Margaret Mary Aloccoque in the 17th century. St. Margaret Mary was a religious sister in France and received visions of Jesus revealing His Sacred Heart to her and commissioning her to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart to the whole world. Eventually, the Church established the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 11th and so the whole month of June takes on particular devotion to the Sacred Heart.

As citizens of the United States, we take seriously the gift of our nation and want to do everything we can to participate in having a flourishing nation. As Catholics, we of course see our nation flourishing to its full potential when it follows God’s will and moral law and stays true to its founding principles. God is the source of our life, happiness and freedom and there would be no better way to celebrate 250 years than to first entrust our whole nation to Jesus and His Sacred Heart. When we do this, we remember Christ’s ultimate Kingship over the whole universe and that He is the true Savior from whom we can receive freedom from sin and the gift of eternal life.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus reminds us of the reality that holiness is found in Him and not in our own perfect efforts. God is holy and we become holy when we become one with God. This begins in Baptism and continues through our journey of walking with God each day and learning to allow Him to work in us and through us. The Sacred Heart is a reminder that we rely on God each day, on His grace and Spirit to give us direction, courage and strength to live well in this life and for Him.

The Sacred Heart also reminds us of Jesus’ intense and burning love for you and me and for the whole human race. There is “fire” in the Sacred Heart and it is the burning fire of God’s love that constantly pursues us and desires to win us over. God is crazy in love with us and will go to the most extreme places to find us and save us if we are only willing to accept this love and allow it to penetrate our whole life. This crazy love of God is revealed in Him coming down from Heaven to become one of His creatures and to go all the way to the cross for us! God shows us in Jesus that there are no limits to His love for us and He will keep coming after us. The Sacred Heart is a true reminder of this burning love.

As our Bishops consecrated our nation to Jesus’ Sacred Heart, may we too entrust and consecrate our lives to the Sacred Heart. Consecrate your homes and your families to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Really entrust all of yourself and your household to His burning Heart of love. This is the first and best gift we can give our nation in honor and gratitude of 250 years – to live for Jesus in His Sacred Heart.

The United States Bishops encourage us to pray as one to the Sacred Heart of Jesus:

O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus:

You know the longings of our hearts, and you desire that we enjoy friendship with you.

From your pierced side, you have poured out the wellspring of life, for which we thirst.

Your heart burns with a love for all people to return to a right relationship with you.

We celebrate the abundant gifts you have given this nation, founded on the self-evident truths that our Creator has endowed all people with the right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

We make reparation for the offenses against you and against human dignity that have taken place in this nation.

May our hearts be united to yours, so that our families and communities enjoy peace and happiness; may broken relationships be reconciled, injustices repaired, and the wounds of our land be healed.

May your holy Catholic Church serve as a sign, pointing all people to your infinite love.

O Desire of Nations and Center of History, we ask you to bless these United States of America.

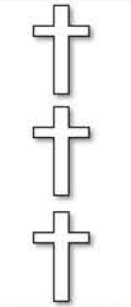
