From the Pastor



Hi everyone!

I know our children are beginning the school year soon, so let's keep them in prayer for a great school year! We also have our parish picnic coming up in two weeks. I hope to see you there!

This weekend on Saturday, August 15th, the Church celebrates the Assumption of Mary body and soul into Heaven. Ordinarily this would be a Holy Day of Obligation but is not this year since it falls on a Saturday. However, I will still use this as an opportunity to share a few thoughts on Mary's bodily Assumption.

If you have ever been over to Europe and/or the Holy Land area, you would have the opportunity to visit the tombs of some of the Apostles and venerate their relics. This is a really awesome experience and I would highly recommend it! As a Church we are claiming that there is no tomb for Mary since her body is nowhere buried on earth but has been Assumed into Heaven. This is a pretty amazing claim!

As we gaze upon the bodies of the Saints set out for us to venerate in Rome and other parts of the world, we are meant to remember the promise of the body being redeemed one day and us being fully united with our bodies in Heaven at the end of time. We experience illness, decay, and struggles with our bodies, but God made them good and for eternity!

The Assumption of Mary is a great sign for us that one day our bodies, too, will be fully glorified by God's grace and the merits of Jesus Christ. Mary enjoys this special privilege now perhaps due to her particular role in salvation history and being the new Ark of the Covenant which housed God Himself in the person of Jesus. The ark was extremely special in the Old Testament since it housed God's presence, and in the New Testament the new Ark is the body of Mary since she gave birth to God in the person of Jesus.

Mary was also given the grace of being sinless and so her body rightly does not see death and decay. As we know Jesus was bodily risen and Ascended to Heaven, and so we have this great hope through Jesus our Savior and Mary His Mother that one day our bodies, too, will be glorified and made perfect for eternity. This is great hope for us as we all experience the imperfection of our bodies here on earth and we truly long for them to not decay! Well, God will fulfill this promise.

On our part, like Mary we should live as a faithful disciple of Jesus and do our best to follow God's will in our lives. We should give Him our daily "yes" as Mary did to the Angel Gabriel in her fiat. We do not always understand God's will on a day-to-day basis, but over time we can see the puzzle fit together. Even in the midst of uncertainty, this feast day is meant to be a concrete reminder of what will happen at the end for us as well – God truly desires us to be fully one in our humanity and promises that to us through Jesus Christ!
