## From the Pastor



Hi, everyone! I am very excited for our parish picnic this week! I would like to thank Parish Council and all the volunteers who have worked so hard to make this a great day for us! I hope to see you there!

In last week's Gospel from Matthew, we heard of Jesus giving Peter the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Jesus makes Peter the rock upon which the Church is built and gives him this binding and loosing authority. It is really incredible all that Jesus bestows upon Peter!

When I was celebrating Liturgy last weekend and hearing this reading multiple times, I kept reflecting on how powerful this passage is and often it seems, as the Church Jesus founded, we are timid to really claim the power in this passage. The reality is we can trace our lineage of Popes and Bishops back to Peter and the Apostles which is really incredible! I do understand that we do not want to be arrogant or prideful with people when discussing the lineage of the Catholic Church, and it truly is important we always have discussions with humility and gentleness, but at the same time, we should not be afraid to claim the great gift of Jesus founding the Church on Peter and tracing our lineage back to Peter through our popes!

As awesome as last week's passage is then when we come to this week, the whole tone changes. Yes, Jesus did build His Church upon Peter and His successors but that doesn't mean we won't have challenges along the way. The very next few verses Peter perhaps lets it get to his head and when Jesus tells him His "plan of attack" Peter resists! Jesus is explaining that He will suffer, die and rise to accomplish a pathway of salvation and Peter says "God forbid, Lord!" No such thing shall ever happen to you!" Then Jesus says in return, "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."

It's pretty incredible to hear this shift in Jesus' voice towards Peter. In one moment, Jesus is giving Peter this great authority and office in His Church and in the next Jesus is calling Peter "Satan" and describing him as an obstacle to Him! Even though Peter's pride gets in the way and Jesus boldly humbles him, Jesus does not remove Peter's office. Jesus corrects Peter and really is forming Peter on the way the Church will operate – through dying and rising.

In our day, we see many moral imperfections in the Church and some are much graver than others. These bad moral behaviors are never acceptable and need to be corrected but it does not stop the Church from being Christ's Church as we see with Peter and the Apostles. Peter will go on to fail more when he denies Jesus during His passion. The other Apostles fail by fleeing from Jesus and Judas betrays Jesus. We see continued moral failure from the Apostles and yet Jesus calls them to repentance still. Again, these moral flaws need corrected but it does not stop the Church from moving forward in the Spirit.

We most likely see moral failure in clergy, and in lay Catholics that we know. Again, these failures need corrected and need to be addressed. You might know plenty of Catholics who are not living the faith well nor are they proclaiming the faith well. Sometimes this can lead us to really question the validity of our faith which is totally understandable. Lets address these problems to the best of our ability but not lose faith in our roots which through the popes and bishops lead us back to Peter and the Apostles!
